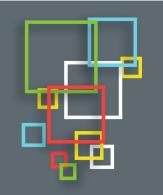

The formation of the New SRO through the merger of IIROC and the MFDA marked the start of an important industry evolution. Where have staff been focusing their efforts since the effective date earlier this year?
